

WISCONSIN MIDDLE SCHOOL BOWLING CLUB GUIDELINES

SCHOOL CLASSIFICATION

Competition will be for Middle School students grades 6th, 7th and 8th.

CONFERENCE

Each conference will consist of a minimum of four teams representing four separate schools.

LEAGUE STRUCTURE

Each school shall field as many boys and girls teams as desired.

LEAGUE PLAYING RULES

Team Structure: A full team consists of five (5) bowlers.
Only ten (10) players can be on each team roster.
Legal lineup consists of three (3) players.

PLAYING FORMAT

Teams will bowl 5 to 9 baker style bowling games.

PRACTICE SESSIONS

It is the responsibility of each coach to conduct at least one practice session per week during the club league season.

UNIFORMS

Each team will be provided shirts.

TRANSPORTATION

It will be the responsibility of each participant in the bowling league, for his/her transportation to and from practices, matches and tournaments. In some cases school policy may dictate the transportation policy, in which case it will be the responsibility of the head coach to conform to the school policy

It will be required that all participants sign waivers of liability, stating they are assuming full responsibility for their transportation and will hold school districts and bowling centers harmless for any actions arising as a result of travel in connection with the Middle School Bowling Club activities.

INSURANCE

The bowling establishment will provide certificates of insurance naming all schools and school districts participating in the Middle School league as additional insurance on their bowling centers commercial insurance package policy.

AWARDS

1st and 2nd place plaques will be provided to the schools in each division in the conference. Individual team members of the 1st and 2nd place teams in each division will receive a trophy or plaque.

COSTS

Low one time fee for entire program. Each bowler will pay a participation fee (suggested \$60.00 to \$75.00), which includes team uniform, practice sessions, school meets and awards.
